

# Assistive Technology Loan Programs in Ohio

The following list was generated through funding from the Ohio Developmental Disabilities Council. The information was entered by the respective agencies and organized by type: Assistive Technology Lending Libraries, Medical Equipment Lending Libraries and Adaptive Toy Lending Libraries.

*Table 1 Types of AT Lending Libraries*

Library Type	Description
<b>Assistive Technology Lending Libraries</b>	Communication (AAC) devices, AT for curriculum-based needs, computer access equipment, mobile devices, some recreation and play, switch access equipment, AT for low-vision/blindness, AT for hard-of-hearing/deafness
<b>Medical Equipment Lending Libraries</b>	Seating and positioning equipment, mobility equipment, activities of daily living equipment
<b>Adaptive Toy Lending Libraries</b>	Adapted toys, recreational items, switches and switch access equipment

**Computer Access Equipment:** adaptive keyboards, mouse pointers, voice recognition

**Mobile Devices:** iPads and/or Android devices loaded with apps

**AT for Curriculum-Based Needs:** reading, writing, math, organization

**AT for low vision/blindness:** Magnifiers, CCTVs, light boxes, braille notetakers, text-to-speech reading devices

**AT for hard-of-hearing/deafness:** FM systems, closed captioning, amplifiers
